



Health and Safety Guidelines

Updated June 202

SSPWC is currently open for in-person appointments that can not be provided effectively via telehealth. As of June, we are limiting the number of providers in the office at one time. SSPWC is a collaborative practice of many specialties. Each provider will follow the SSPWC health and safety guidelines created, as well as any additional guidelines specific to their sector of practice. We will continue to adjust our safety guidelines and office protocols in accordance with any new state mandated guidelines that are released and appreciate your patience and understanding as we continue to adapt. You will be notified immediately by your provider of any changes to the policies outlined here that will affect your treatment or interaction with the SSPWC. We ask that you adhere to the following guidelines while in the center.

ILLNESS

If you or anyone in your household has a fever, cough, sore throat, or otherwise are not feeling well, you will contact your provider to cancel your appointment or proceed using telehealth.

Inform your provider if you or any person present at your appointment tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of being at the SSPWC.

If you or anyone in your household tests positive for COVID-19, you will not be able to enter the center until you test negative and no longer have symptoms.

YOUR VISIT

Please text or call your provider upon arrival to the center. Remain in your car, until your provider informs you they are ready for your appointment. Your provider will meet you at the front door of the center, ask for confirmation that you are not experiencing any symptoms of illness before welcoming you into the building. You will be asked to sanitize or wash your hands and brought immediately into your provider's office.

The use of the waiting room is not allowed at this time.

Please limit the number of people that accompany you to your appointment. Any person who accompanies you to your appointment must remain with you in the provider's office you will be seen in. For those with children, we encourage you to make childcare arrangements for your appointments whenever possible.

Unless your appointment requires close contact (ex: midwife appointment, massage therapy), your provider will maintain a 6 foot distance at all times.

Please be assured that the center, including bathrooms will frequently be cleaned. All provider offices will be cleaned between each appointment (high-touch areas disinfected). Please ask your provider if you would like more details about our cleaning policies.

CONFIDENTIALITY

If you have tested positive for COVID-19 we may be required to notify local health authorities that you have been at the center. If we have to report this, we will only provide the minimum information necessary for their data collection and will not go into any details about the reason(s) for our visits. By submitting this form, you are agreeing that we may do so without an additional signed release.
